Potash Project Hires Feasibility Study Group

IC Potash Corp. announced this week that SNC-Lavalin Group Inc. has been awarded a Contract by ICP to develop several key sections of the feasibility study of ICP's Ochoa sulphate of potash project in Lea County.



Work on the feasibility study is already under-way and is expected to be completed by August 2013.

The technical scope of the feasibility study includes the recovery methods, project infrastructure, processing facility, load out and ancillary services to produce SOP and sulphate of potash magnesia from ICP's polyhalite deposit located in the southeastern region of New Mexico.

The overall project will include the process design and optimization of the SOP and SOPM process, along with materials handling, granulation and load out of the finish products.

SNC-Lavalin will also develop the cost estimate and assist ICP in the economic analysts of the Ochoa Project with input from other key consultants contracted by ICP.

SOP and SOPM are premium fertilizer products and SNC-Lavalin brings significant knowledge and experience with this type of processing facility.

The Company also recently announced it had appointment of Bob Mueller as Senior Vice President of Internal Development.
